### **FOREWORD**

MPKV is the recipient of Sardar Vallabhai Patel Best Agriculture University Award (2002), Rs. 100 crore special grants as Institution of Excellence by the Government of India (2008) and the most preferred institution (2009).

MPKV is celebrating its Golden Jubilee year of its establishment. Various programmes has been organized to celebrate this memorable event. Effective technology application is implemented through the Regional and District Extension Centres, Krishi Vigyan Kendras supervised by the Directorate of Extension Education. Capacity development programmes are organized for the Agril. Officers, Extension personnel, Subject Matter Specialists and representatives of Kisan Call Centres. Demonstrations on improved varieties and technologies released by the university have been organized in cluster approach through the Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana- Farmer FIRST and ICAR Farmer FIRST programmes. Outreach programmes organized by the university significantly contributed to reduce the yield gaps and resulting in increasing the production and productivity of various crop commodities.

A mega event *Kisan Aadhar Sammelan* - 2017 was organized in this university with moto of New India Manthan: *Sanklap se Siddhi, Unnat Sheti- Samrudh Shetkari* campaign. A large number of farmers visited the crop demonstrations and agriculture, animal exhibition and also participated in farmers- scientists interactions.

Last year the university has released 10 crop varieties, 2 improved agricultural implements and 50 technology recommendations. This included - Bajara: Phule Mahashakti, Sugarcane: Phule 10001, Rajmah: Phule Rajmah, Groundnut: Phule Bharati, Barnyard millet: Phule Bharti-1, Oat: Phule Surbhi, Marvel: Marvel-09-4, Sponge gourd: Phule Kamal, Cenchrus (Madras Anjan): RCC-10-6, Custard apple: Phule Janaki and Tomato: Phule Kesar and agricultural implements like Tractor operated Phule Sugarcane Transplanter and Power operated Phule Sugarcane sett cutter.

The university has established new Agriculture college named after Punyashlok Ahilyadevi Holkar at Halgaon, Dist-Ahmednagar. The Hon'ble Chief Minister of Maharashtra state Shri. Devendra Fadanvis laid down the foundation stone of this college. The number of affiliated colleges have gone up, while, Agriculture Technology Schools have opened the doors of agricultural education for students in rural areas. Students from number of foreign countries are also seeking admissions in the university.


