		5% NSK Extract @5 ml per liter of water.		
		Do not give green maize fodder to cattle's immediate after spraying of insecticide		
		and do not use this green maize fodder for silage making immediate after spraying.		
Safflower	Flowering	Due to the cloudy and humid weather over the past week, there is a		
	Stage	likelihood of blight disease in safflower. For its control, spray a combined		
		fungicide of Carbendazim + Mancozeb at 2 grams per liter of water.		
		Additionally, for the control of pod borer in safflower, spray Fenvalerate 20		
XX71		EC at 5 ml per 10 liters of water.		
Wheat	Panicle	At present, the panicles are out. In such a case irrigation should be given		
	formation	when there is no wind. Because of that there is a possibility logging in		
	stage	wheat crop. The crop should not be irrigated by sprinkler irrigation after the		
		emergence of panicles. Because of this, the luster of the wheat grains		
		decreases and the quality decreases.		
		Spray the crop with Thiamethoxam (25 WG) at 1 gram or Acetamiprid (20		
		SP) at 5 grams per 10 liters of water for the control of aphids.

		should be done and 2 weeding should be given.			
		Spray Dimethoate 30 EC @ 17 ml per 10 liters of water for control of thrips and

Vegetable		The first dose of nitrogen fertilizer as per the crop wise recommendation			
crops		should be given after weeding the vegetable crop planted in January.			
Animal		Due to the rising in temperatures, keep animals in shade and give them			
Husbandry		plenty of clean and cold water to drink.			
_		Give them green grass, protein-fat bypass supplement, mineral mixture and			
		salt. Make them graze during cooler hours.			
		Cover the shed roof with straw, Also, paint the walls white or plaster with			
		dung-mud to reduce temperature.
