General Advisory		Use Meghdoot mobile app for weather based crop advisory and prediction.					
SMS Advisory		Grass/ crop residues/ polyethylene should be used as mulching to save soil					
		moisture.					
Harvested	Harvesting	Plowing should be done immediately in the area of harvested <i>rabi</i> crops so
