	Give them green grass, protein-fat bypass supplement, mineral mixture and			
	salt. Make them graze during cooler hours.			
	Cover the shed roof with straw, Also, paint the walls white or plaster with			
	dung-mud to reduce temperature.			
Poultry	Provide curtains and proper ventilation in poultry house. Also, paint the			
	walls white or plaster with dung-mud to reduce temperature.
