General	Advisory	Grass/ crop residues/ polyethylene should be used as mulching to save soil					
		moisture.					
		Farm Workers should avoid working in direct sunlight.					
		The crops should be lightly irrigated as required to ensure that standing					
		crops do not get water stress due to rise in temperature.					
		Irrigation frequency should be increased during critical growth stage of					
		crops.
