Crop	Stage	Agromet Advisory
Weather Forecast Summary		<ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ According to weather forecast given by India Meteorological Department, Regional Meteorological Centre, Mumbai, During next five days Maximum and minimum temperature may ranges between 35 degree Celsius and 18 to 20 degree Celsius respectively.➤ As per Extended Range Weather Forecast (ERFS) maximum and minimum temperatures above average between 4th to 10th March, 2021 over Madhya Maharashtra region.
General Advisory		<ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ Keep crops weed free by intercultivation on time. Carry out plant protection measures to protect the crop from pest and diseases infestations on time.
SMS Advisory		<ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ During next five days weather may dry over the district.
Gram	Maturity To Harvesting Stage	<ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ If the rainfed gram is mature, it should be harvested and threshed. The gram should be dried in the sun for 6-7 days and stored in a dry and well ventilated place. Do not harvest when the crop is moist.
Wheat	Development Stage To Maturity	<ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ Late sown wheat crop should be irrigated 80 to 85 days after sowing at grain filling stage. Harvest timely sown mature crop harvest and store at safe place.
Rabi Sorghum	Maturity Stage	<ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ Irrigate late sown sorghum when crop is at grain filling stage. Harvest timely sown mature crop harvest and store at safe place.

Rabi Maize	Harvesting	➤ Maize should be harvested when the husk cover is yellowish white and firm. Harvest and dry it in the sun for 2-3 days.
Groundnut	Germination Stage	➤ Carry out Gap filling after germination immediately. Apply irrigation 4-5 days after sowing of groundnut so that the remaining seeds germinate. Then irrigate 10 to 12 times at intervals of 8 to 10 days as per soil type.
Onion	Early Maturity Stage	➤ For Rabi onion, Irrigation should be stopped 10 to 15 days before harvest. Harvest the crop after 50% of the leaves have fallen.
Papaya	Development Stage	➤ For the control of Aphids spray Dimethoate 10 ml OR Neemark 10 ml per 10 liters of water at 15 days interval.
Watermelon	Development stage	➤ Apply 50 kg Nitrogen fertilizer to watermelon 30, 45 and 60 days after planting.
Banana	Fruit Development Stage	➤ Two lines of wind breaks at 2 m around the banana orchard should be laid at a distance. Shaveri or Gajraj grass etc. should be used for wind breaks. The garden should be fenced on all four sides.
Mango	Blooming to Fruiting Stage	➤ Due to the increase in temperature and decrease in humidity, pea to betel-shaped fruits in mango orchards are likely to fall on ground. To falling of this fruiting, depending on the availability of water, irrigate field at weekly intervals to the stage of betel nut size.
Poultry	Bird Flu	<ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ Do's in backyard poultry rearing:➤ Avoid contact with migratory birds in your poultry.➤ Wash birds water and food containers daily.➤ Keep the poultry shed clean.➤ Vaccinate the poultry birds regularly.➤ If any of poultry birds get sick or die, report it immediately to the nearest veterinary officer.➤ Don'ts in backyard poultry rearing:➤ Avoid contact with poultry droppings and nasal discharge.➤ Avoid handling poultry birds as much as possible, wash hands with soap if handled.➤ Do not leave poultry birds water and food outdoors.➤ Make sure that other species of birds / animals do not come in the area.
