It is, therefore, requested to please send your lowest price/rate quotation to this office on or before 25/06/2026 considering the following term and conditions.

Terms and Conditions -

1. The rates quoted must be inclusive of all applicable taxes, duties, packing, forwarding, and insurance charges, and FOR Destination (Pesticide Residue Laboratory, MPKV, Rahuri).
2. The invoice must contain a clear break-up of GST and must strictly reflect the prices mentioned in the approved quotation.
3. The rates quoted must remain valid for a minimum period of 90 days from the due date of submission of the quotation.
4. Prices should be quoted for a 50 mg pack size. If this specific packing is unavailable, the price must be quoted for the next available standard packing size, and the prices will be compared on a pro-rata basis against the standard requirement.
5. The supplier must explicitly state the make, brand, and catalogue number for each offered item, failing which the quotation will be summarily rejected.
6. All reference standards must possess ISO 17034 traceability and documentary evidence verifying this traceability must be provided at the time of delivery, failing which the payment will not be made and the supplier will have to collect the material at their own cost.
7. An individual Certificate of Analysis (COA) for each item must be provided along with the supplied material.
8. The items must be from the latest production batch and must be delivered with a minimum remaining shelf life of two years from the date of delivery.
9. The supplier must have a registered office within the jurisdiction of India, and valid proof of the same (PAN and GST registration details) must be attached to the quotation.
10. If the bidder is not the Original Equipment Manufacturer (OEM), a valid Manufacturer's Authorization Certificate must be enclosed.
11. The successful supplier must deliver the material within 4 to 6 weeks from the date of issue of the purchase order.
12. The supplier shall be fully responsible for any loss, damage or shortage in transit and ensures the safe delivery of goods in good condition at the Pesticide Residue Laboratory, MPKV, Rahuri.
13. If any material supplied is found to be defective at a later stage, the same must be replaced immediately by the supplier at free of cost.
14. The number of items may increase or decrease up to 25% at the time of placing the purchase order depending on the actual requirement of the laboratory, without any change in unit price or other terms.
15. 100% payment shall be made only against the successful delivery and inspection of the material in good condition.
16. Sealed quotations must be sent to the Head, Department of Entomology, MPKV, Rahuri - 413722, Dist. Ahilyanagar and the envelope must be strictly super-scribed as 'Quotation for the Supply of Certified Reference Materials'.
17. This office will not be responsible for any postal or transit delays, and quotations received after the due date will not be considered under any circumstances.
