| Animal<br>husbandry | - | Care should be taken to ensure that contaminated or silty water does not enter the drinking water of animals. Deworm animals. Sulfa tablets should be used for the diarrhea caused by young grass.  |  |  |  |  |  |
|---------------------|---|---|--|--|--|--|--|
|                     |   | Animals should not be tied up in open spaces. They should be kept in a barn, shed, or a building with a solid wall.   |  |  |  |  |  |
|                     |   | If there is a rainy weather and lightning, farm work should be stopped immediately and the animals should be moved to a closed shed or safe place. The roof and walls of the barn should not be made of metal, as metals attract lightning. If animals are in the water, immediately pull them out.                     |  |  |  |  |  |
|                     |   | If your hair stands/ straight or your skin tingles during a sudden thunderstorm, you may be struck by lightning. To protect yourself, immediately lie on the ground with your knees bent, your arms wrapped around your knees, and your chin resting on your knees. Once the weather clears, reach shelter immediately. |  |  |  |  |  |
|                     |   | If there is a sudden thunderstorm and there are only trees around, crouch down on the ground at a distance of twice the height of the tree.   |  |  |  |  |  |
| Water<br>Recharge   | - | Try not to let the water percolate into the soil too much. Rainwater from the roof of the house should be collected in a tank through a pipe and used for well or bore well recharge.   |  |  |  |  |  |
