Safflower	Sowing	Sowing of rabi safflower can be done from the second fortnight of September to the first week of October. For sowing of rabi safflower verities, biofertilizer, fertilizer etc should be planned. Straight / hybrid varieties recommended for sowing of safflower should be selected. For sowing in dryland areas of safflower, varieties like Bhima, Phule Kusuma, Phule Kardai-733 should be selected. For dryland as well as irrigated safflower S.S. F708, Phule Chandrabhaga (S. S. F. 748), Phule Nira S. S. F.12-40, Phule Bhivara S. S. F.13-71, Phule Gold S. S. F.15-65, Phule Kiran S. S. F.16-02, Nari-06 those varieties should be selected.
Sugarcane	Sowing	Pre seasonal sugarcane is planted between 15 th October to 15 th November. Carry out land preparation for Preseasonal Sugarcane planting. Select varieties like Co.86032 (Nira), Co.M0265 (Phule 265), M.S.10001 (Phule 10001), CO.94012 (Phule Savitri) for cultivation
