General A	Advisory	1) Care should be taken to ensure that water does not accumulate in the				
		field. If water accumulates in the field, by digging out trenches drain out				
		the excess water.				
		2) Due to the possibility of rain, keep harvested crops in safe place/ shed or				
		covered with plastic paper.				
		3) Farm operations (Interculturing, weed management, Fertilizer				
		application, spraying etc.) should be done after the rainfall stops and				
		wapasaa condition.				
		4) In case of manual field operations of harvesting/ picking, accomplish the operation in 4-5 feet spaced strips assigning one strip to one person. This will ensure adequate social distance to engaged labours. Agricultural machinery should be sanitized frequently. Farmer should use face mask.				
		5) Farmers should take necessary precautionary measures while spraying				
		insecticide, fungicide etc.				
		6) Use "Meghdoot" mobile app for weather based crop advisory and prediction.				
		7) Use "Damini" mobile app for electricity forecasting.
