Weather Summary		Weather forecast given by Regional Meteorological Centre, Mumbai has indicated there is forecast of generally cloudy sky on 24 th , 25 th , 26 th , 27 th and 28 th June in Sangli district. There is forecast of light rainfall on 24th, 25th, 26th, 27th and 28th June at isolated places in Sangli district. During next 5 days and Tmax may remain between 30.0 to 32.0°C, minimum temperature may remain nearby 22.0 to 23.0. Morning relative humidity will remain nearby 82 to 84% and Afternoon relative humidity will remain nearby 62 to 68%. Wind speed will remain between 12 to 21 km per hour.								
ERFS		According to the Extended Range Forecast (ERF) for the Madhya Maharashtra Sub-Division during 26 th June to 2 nd July below normal rainfall is expected. The maximum temperatures are likely to remain above normal, while minimum temperatures are expected to stay above normal throughout this period

Sugarcane	Establishment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Use light traps for control of White grubs. ➤ Keep the sugarcane field weed free. 								
Tomato	Growth	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Due to moderate rainfall and gusty winds, tomato plants may lodge. Provide staking support to tomato plants using bamboo sticks to prevent lodging. ➤ Avoid spraying insecticides and pesticides during warning period

Pomogranate	Fruit Maturity	➤ Carry out harvesting of matured fruits and keep the harvested produce at safe place
Banana	Vegetative growth	➤ Due to moderate rainfall and gusty winds, tomato plants may lodge. Provide staking support to tomato plants using bamboo sticks to prevent lodging.
Bajara	Presowing	➤ Varieties : Phule Aadishakti, Phule Dhanshakti Improved : Dhanshakti
Soybean	Presowing	➤ Varieties : Select varieties of Soybean like <i>Phule Kimaya</i> (KDS 753), <i>Phule Sangam</i> (KDS 726), <i>Phule Agrani</i> (KDS 344), <i>Phule Kalyani</i> (DS 228)
Groundnut	Presowing	➤ Varieties : Phule Unnati, Phule Dhani, Phule Morana, Phule Varana,
Cowpea	Presowing	➤ Varieties : Phule Rukhmini, Phule Sonali
Animals	Growth	➤ Ensure that the drinking water for animals is clean and free from dirt or contaminants. ➤ Improve the immunity of the animals to control and prevent parasite infestations. To achieve this, provide a well-balanced and nutritious diet. Keep the animal shed clean, dry, and well-ventilated, and carry out regular disinfection. While administering medicines, ensure the correct dosage is given. ➤ Do not keep animals in open spaces. House them in sheds or sturdy structures to ensure their safety and well-being. ➤ During rainy weather and thunderstorms, immediately stop field work and move the animals to a sheltered and secure location.
